

Students have limited checkout because regular and frequent access needs to be balanced with commitment.

Check Out Routine



- 1. Grab a shelf marker.
- 2. Think about where to browse.
- 3. Browse for books.
- 4. Place a shelf marker in the book spot.
- 5. Grab the book.
- 6. Decide if it is a good fit book for check out.
 - a. Yes, take the book and the shelf marker out.
 - b. No, put the book back in the shelf marker place and repeat steps 3-6.
